Dear Mr NEWLAND.

Enclosed is your new Amateur Licence. Please read it through carefully in conjunction with this letter and when you have done so store it in a safe place so that you can refer to it readily, or produce it for inspection.

The licence has been revised for two reasons:-

1. To give you greater flexibility to pursue each aspect of amateur radio without having to apply to us each time for authority to do so.
2. We, in turn, expect to be able to keep within the Government's staff ceiling over the next few years while maintaining the issue of amateur licences without undue delays.

The principal changes are on the first page, but you will need to familiarise yourself with the Schedule to ensure that you limit use of facilities to the correct bands.

Be sure also to read the clauses concerning call signs and log-keeping.

Your expired licence and any licence supplemental to the main licence must be returned to this Department using the gummed label provided.
